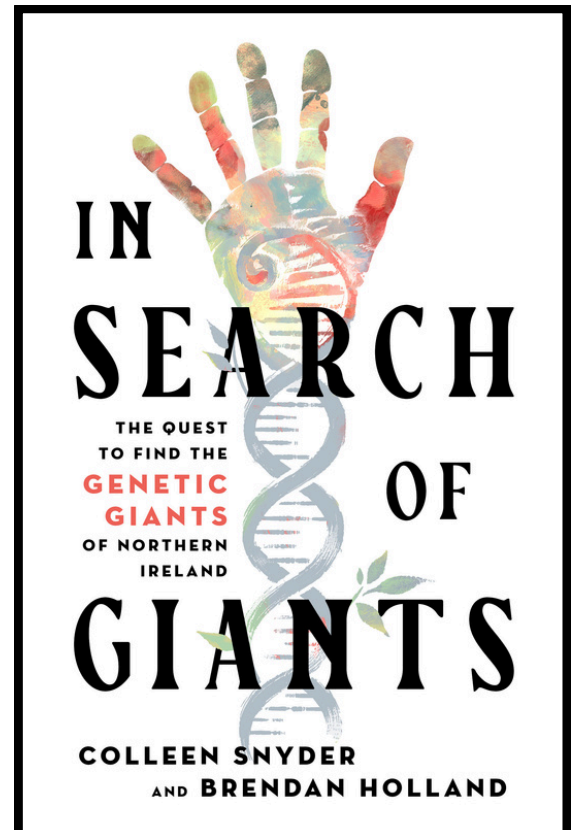

Colleen Snyder is an author, researcher, and speaker with a passion for uncovering stories that connect science, history, and humanity. Her debut book, *In Search of Giants: The Quest to Find the Genetic Giants of Northern Ireland*, blends groundbreaking genetic research with Irish folklore and personal storytelling to illuminate the lives of those affected by the rare condition of gigantism.

In 2020, Colleen became the first person in the U.S. identified with the Irish variant of the AIP genetic mutation tied to gigantism. This discovery inspired her to explore her Irish roots, learn the Irish language, and connect with others worldwide who share her genetic legacy.

Colleen's writing has been featured in *The Washington Post*, *Destinations Magazine*, and *The Endocrinologist*. As an engaging and dynamic speaker, she offers audiences insight into topics ranging from rare diseases to Irish genealogy, always leaving them with the message that connection and community can be found, no matter the challenge.

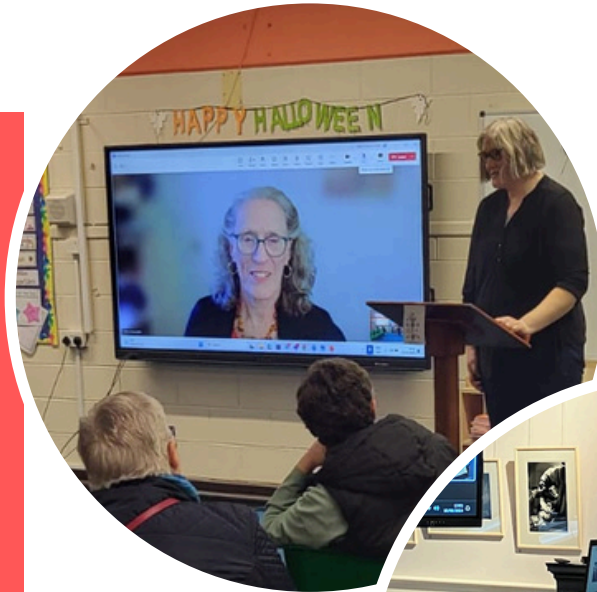
